AMENDED NOTICE OF VIRTUAL HEARING ON FIRST DAY MOTIONS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, on April 9, 2026 (the “Petition Date”), the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the “Debtors”) filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”) with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas, Houston Division (the “Court”).

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in accordance with sections A and I of the *Procedures for Complex Chapter 11 Cases* in the Southern District of Texas, the hearing previously scheduled before the Honorable U.S. Bankruptcy Judge Perez has been reset. The hearing will now be held on **April 10, 2026 at 2:00 p.m.** (prevailing Central Time), before the Honorable U.S. Bankruptcy Judge Christopher M. Lopez, to consider the following:
